Hamlet (2009) featuring David Tennant








Please purchase a **physical copy** of the Folger Library edition (you will need it for class in the fall). As you are watching, make notes in the book (or in an **organized** accompanying notebook) about how each version delivers various scenes or characters. Also, be sure to note if and when changes or omissions happen.

Your annotations should focus on the acting or directorial choices designed to provide insight into the characters being portrayed. Note down aspects such as pacing; delivery of lines; setting; costumes; camera angles or movements (cinematography); or other film-making details. What stands out, and how do these choices convey meaning throughout the movie?



The annotations will be a checked grade upon your return to school in the fall, and you will be using them to complete in-class assignments and writing **about the portrayal of the character Hamlet**, specifically how the director desired the audience to interpret him. You should also be prepared for a brief assessment on the viewing of the movies.
